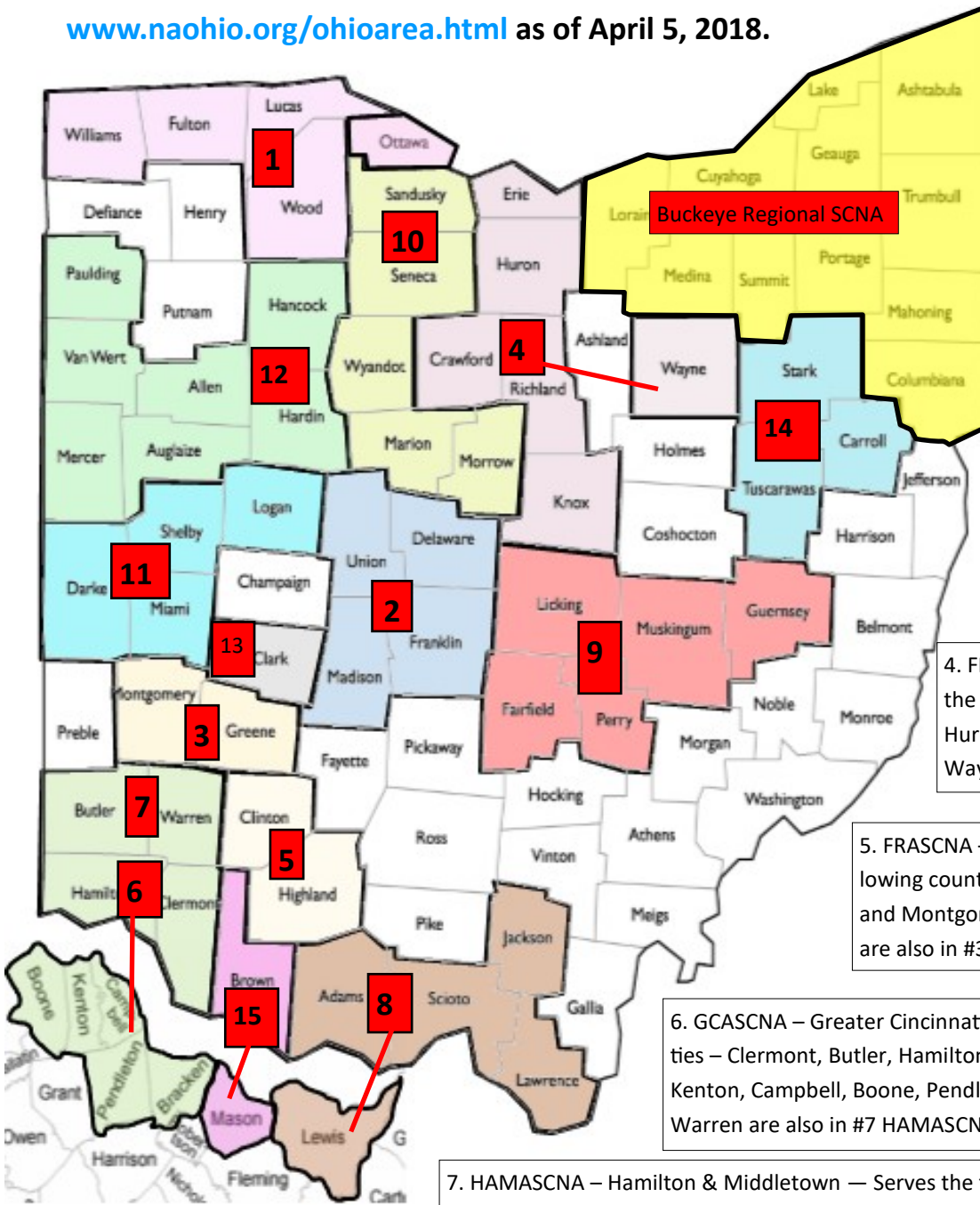

1. BLASCNA – Best Little Area—Fulton, Lucas, Ottawa, Williams, and Wood

2. COASCNA – Central Ohio Area – Delaware, Fairfield (which is also in #9 MEASCNA) Franklin, Madison, and Union.

3. DASCNA – Dayton Area – Serves the following counties – Greene and Montgomery (both of which are also in #5 FRASCNA?)

4. FFASCNA – Finally Free – Serves the following counties – Crawford, Huron, Knox, Richland, Erie and Wayne

5. FRASCNA – Five Rivers – Serves the following counties – Greene, Clinton, Highland, and Montgomery (Montgomery and Greene are also in #3 DASCNA?)

6. GCASCNA – Greater Cincinnati – Serves the following counties – Clermont, Butler, Hamilton, and Warren; In Kentucky – Kenton, Campbell, Boone, Pendleton, and Bracken. (Butler and Warren are also in #7 HAMASCNA?)

7. HAMASCNA – Hamilton & Middletown – Serves the following counties – Butler and Warren (which are also in #6 GSASCNA?)

8. KORASCNA – KY & OH Recovery – Serves Adams, Jackson, Lawrence, and Scioto; in Kentucky – Lewis.

13. SASCNA – Springfield— Serves Clark County

9. MEASCNA – Mid East Area – Serves the following counties – Fairfield, Guernsey, Licking, Muskingum, and Perry.

14. STASCNA – Stark, Tuscarawas, and Carroll Services – Serves Stark, Tuscarawas, and Carroll counties

10. MOASCNA – Mid OH – Serves the following counties – Marion, Morrow, Sandusky, Seneca, and Wyandot.

15. UASCNA – Unity Area – Serves Brown county in OH and Mason county in Kentucky

11. MVASCNA – Miami Valley – Serves the following counties – Darke, Greene, Logan, Miami, and Shelby

BUCKEYE REGIONAL SERVICE COMMITTEE – The Buckeye Region serves Northeast Ohio Areas which include the following counties: Ashtabula, Trumbull, Mahoning, Columbiana, Lake, Geauga, Portage, Stark (which is also in #14, STASCNA), Cuyahoga, Summit, Medina, Lorain, Wayne & Carroll. See nabuckeye.org
